The School Initiation programme & Teaching practice.

From the year 2015 onwards as per the revised norms of NCTE, for improving the quality of Teacher Education, the duration of B.Ed course was extended to two years and the students' strength was reduced from 150 to 50. In our college this year students' strength was raised from 50 to 100 by the government. This academic year commenced on 1st June & the classes for juniors started on 13th July 2016 and has a total of 142 students on rolls. The school Initiation programme was conducted for juniors from 16/01/2017 to 20/01/2017. Teaching practice was conducted for seniors from 29th July to 30th August 2016 and the internship programme for seniors from 09/11/2016 to 31/01/2017.
