

Webinar-1 Topic: Impact of COVID-19 on Kerala Economy: Experiences and Reflections)
Resource Person: Prof.(Dr.)K.C.Baiju

Hoping a better tomorrow, free from COVID-19 pandemic we began our webinar series with prayer song, Guru's Daivadashakam sang by Neeni SL at 10.35 am. The topic of the webinar was *Impact of COVID-19 on Kerala Economy: Experiences and Reflections* by Prof.(Dr.)K C Baiju, (Former Vice Chancellor(I/C), Professor and Dean.School of Economics, Central University of Kerala, Kasaragod). Dr. Reetha Ravi H (Assistant Professor) did the anchoring of the webinar. She invited Dr. Smitha S (Assistant Professor,SNTC & IQAC Coordinator) at 10.40 am to welcome the resource person, and beneficiaries of the webinar. She welcomed all and introduced the resource person to us. Around 120+ participants attended the webinar from different parts of and across Kerala.

The presidential address was presided over by Dr. Sheeba P (Principal, SNTC). The aim of the webinar series was to create better digitalized teachers who are combatable to face any pandemic condition like COVID-19. She shared some queries to Mr. Baiju on the student's unawareness of economic bill, how to deal with Onam expenses in this pandemic situation. She wished a grand success to the webinar. She aspired that the *Intelligentia Beyond Disciplines* could turn the negative externalities to positive externalities.

The management representative Sri. Aji SRM did key note address to the webinar series. He said that with the economic difficulties there occurred a drastic change in education field. The offline mode fully converted to online mode. He wished a fruitful webinar series to the students. Dr. Pramod G Nair, (Assistant Professor, SNTC) offered the felicitation speech to the venture. He desired the webinar series may be an imaginative and fruitful one having human touch.

Dr. K C Baiju started his presentation by remembering Sree Narayana Guru and Nobel Prize winner Amarthya Sen. He said that COVID-19 is not a regional one but a national health and economic crisis. It threatened the psychic, social and economic balance of people. A drastic change occurred in all the economic fields across the world. Tourism, the economic treasure of India was affected badly. The break the chain campaigns proclaimed social distancing everywhere. It affected the migrant population in India as well as world. The majority of Kerala economy is based on the money of migrants.

The lack of liquid amount, shortage of raw material, crude oil price hike, the low demand of spices from Kerala affected the economy in Lock down days. The capital money was not invested in industrial sectors. Small enterprises, manufacturing, trade service sectors – significant contributors of SDP – already affected with implementation confronted with the dichotomy of 'liquidity and solvency'. The production in industries was stopped due to lock down. Without production, the employment opportunities diminished. Unemployment is spreading world-wide. None is secured. Many migrants were disbanded from the companies due to recession. 4 lakh migrants were evacuated.

The economic instability affected agricultural and industrial field. The steel, aluminium, coal industries were disrupted. 4.5crore people lost their jobs in textile and apparels. It also affected MSME (Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises) in India. Post COVID 19 looms uncertainty for informal workers in general and migrant workers in particular. Now too much money is to be pumped to paramedical, primary health fields in India for a better future.

The Indian Policy Responses to COVID-19 were also discussed. *Atmanirbhar* (self-sufficient) package was introduced by Govt of India. The economy, infrastructure, system, demography and demand are the five pillars looking for a pace change in self-reliant India. Five tranches of economic aid was introduced by Nirmala Seetharaman, the Finance minister of India was mentioned. He said that the economy and economics cannot be discussed without explaining history. Kerala is a true warrior. The economy may get depleted in a consumerist state like Kerala due to the on slot of inflicted floods, landslides, Nipah virus. But Kerala, the God's own country together faced it all.

The resource person suggested that job switching, gig economy, total casualization can be done to sustain in the Post COVID 19 India. The conventional skill may not help, alternative skills should be made polished to sustain in the future. Gig economy is a type of online shopping culture.

Now we get everything under sun with a single touch. A drastic change will happen in online marketing. There is no security of employment. If you are doing a job, then it is complimentary in future. Added skills will help you in future. So should promote experiential learning in academics for a better tomorrow.

In the Q&A session our teaching faculty asked some questions to the resource person. Dr. Smitha S asked more about skill switching. Pramod sir asked a query on interstate labourers in Kerala. The resource person said that from cradle to graveyard, almost all the works were done by the interstate employers. They returned to their homeland due to lock down. Kerala pay decent money for the work done by them. So they will come back to Kerala for labour in future. Dr. Sheeba P asked a pharmacy related question. Dr. KC Baiju answered all questions well.

He concluded that there are mainly 3 types of jobs – Blue collar job, white collar job, green collar job. We should shift our vision from white collar job and focus on others too. He said that the NEP will make a great change in education field. He mentioned the autonomous universities like AMITY University, JAIN University, which focuses on job based education. They try to ensure skill development in their students, which is essential now in India. With theoretical knowledge they were culturing skills and upgrading it to next level. The skill switching and the drastic changes in education field will make India heaven in future. The session ended with the vote of thanks by Ms Aparna R, the former vice chairman of HIRAYA (college union).



Webinar-2 Topic: 'LIBRARY AT YOUR FINGERTIPS'

The internal quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of SNTC, Nedunganda organized a webinar series "Intelligentia beyond Disciplines-Cross Disciplinary collaboration in education" with all departments of college. The 2nd webinar session of the series was on the topic "Library at your fingertips" on 28 Aug 2020 at 10.30 am over the video communication service platform, Google meet.

The programme started with prayer by Parvathy.A.Kurup. Dr.Reetha Ravi (Assistant professor, SNTC) anchored the programme. Sri.Karingannur Sreekumar (Scientific Information Officer, College of Engineering, TVPM) and Sri.Alex.C.O (Managing Director, Libsost Solutions, TVPM) were the resource persons. The topics are "Digital Library-an introduction" and "Web-based digital library" respectively. The

anchor invited Sri.Babu Sunil (Convener/Librarian, SNTC) to deliver the welcome speech. He also introduced the resource persons and mentioned about the history of library. Around 100+ participants attended the webinar.

The webinar was presided over by Dr. Sheeba.P (Principal, SNTC). The purpose of the webinar was to help the public to understand the possibilities of Digital Library. She wished a grand success for the webinar.

Sri.R.Sain (Senior Librarian, Govt. Ayurveda Medical College, and TVPM) felicitated the function. He quoted about the traditional libraries and the digital forms. He also shared his views on the digital divide that existing in today's society and the importance of cultivating traditional reading habits among students.

Sri.Karingannur Sreekumar conveyed his resource talk in "Digital Library-an introduction" as simple and interesting as possible. First of all, he cleared the difference between automation of a library and the concept of digital library. He familiarized us, about the various digital libraries all our country and the soft wares used to digitalizes the libraries. Shodhganga is one of the digital libraries under MHRD. D Space is open source repository software packages typically used for creating open assess repositories for scholarly and published digital content. There are several digital library applications. National Digital Library of India, Google library, DOAB (Directory of Open Access Books) are some of them. He also discussed about how to make a digital repository. A Digital repository is a collection of online resources and is essential for digital library. He concluded with a pleasant message about the importance of keeping a good habit of reading and values. He added the effectiveness of library in moulding one's personality.

Sri.Alex.C.O conducted the resource talk on "Web-based digital library". He differentiated the concepts of digital library and web-based digital library. We could set up a Web-based digital library at the same rate of a server computer and can access from anywhere. He talked about the need of Web-based digital libraries for students. He showed the websites of digital libraries in several colleges and he briefed on the content. The Web-based digital Library of Nirmala College of Arts and Science took as a model for that. The Homepage contains icons such as e-books which have the book resources and its sites, e-journals, repository related to colleges, web opac, gallery, online courses, live news, notice board, e-newspapers etc.

He also provided information on how to implement Web-based digital library in an institution. In a nut shell, he explained the things to be followed in a web-based digital library and needs.

In the Q&A session students clarified their doubts about talk. The formal session came to an end with the Vote of thanks of Artdhanadevi.P. The Webinar wind up with the National Anthem.



that no specific treatment have yet been identified for novel Covid-19 and proper nutrition and healthy life style are important factors to be safe in the pandemic.



Despite of this current complex situation our college had organized a webinar series "Intelligentia Beyond Disciplines". This webinar series is organised by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) collaborated with all departments of Sree Narayana Training College, Nedunganda. The 4th webinar of this webinar series on the topic "Covid-19 And Teaching Community" was conducted on September 19, 2020. The resource talk on this topic was led by Dr.A. Shershah (Associate Professor & Head (Rtd.), TKM College of Arts & Science, Kollam. Founder President, National Wellness Association. Principal Investigator, UGC Minor Research project on 'Exercise & Diseases'.

Our webinar series was started with a payer sung by Ms. Ashwathy.B. S at 10:35 am. The anchoring was done by Ms. Neethu.G.L. She invited Sri. Amjith.S (Assistant Professor of SNTC & Convener). He welcomed the resource person and all others who were attending the webinar at 10:40am. About hundred participants were present at the webinar. Ms. Neethu invited Dr. Sheeba.P (Principal, SNTC & General Convener) for presiding the presidential address. Today medicines for different diseases are available in Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Allopathy etc. But we do not know to what extend these medicines are successful. So, prevention of diseases is better than cure especially in the present situation. For that the only thing we can do is boosting our immunity. She made us aware about the importance of boosting our immunity especially in this pandemic situation. She said that Dr. A. Shershah sir is the right person who can make us aware about what we can do to boost our immunity. She insisted us to utilize this opportunity to the maximum extend by making this an interactive session. After the presidential address Ms. Neethu invited Sri. Praveen.R (Assistant Professor, SNTC) for delivering the felicitation speech. He also said us to utilize this opportunity maximum by asking our doubts and making this an interactive session.

Dr. Viji.V (Assistant Professor, SNTC) introduced the resource person Dr. A. Shershah. Ms. Neethu invited Dr. A. Shershah for the presentation of topic. He started the presentation by thanking Dr. Viji.V, Dr. Sheeba.P, and Sri. Praveen.R. He addressed Dr. Sheeba.P as a dynamic principal. He thanked Dr. Praveen.R for the covid-19 tips provided by him during the felicitation speech. Before starting the topic, he said that he had gone to many colleges for presenting many topics but Sree Narayana Training College is very different and special for him because this college is a college of teaching community.

The presentation of topic was started by saying that we are all afraid of covid-19 because of high death rates caused by this disease. Then he discussed about SARS. After that he asked a question "why high death rates are there due to covid". And made us aware that percentage of death of non-communicable diseases is higher than that of death caused due to communicable diseases. Major cause of premature death caused by communicable disease is due to preexisting symptoms. World Health Organistion stated that in the case of covid-19 also no one had died due to covid-19 only. Most of the death are due to certain other preexisting symptoms. There are a wide variety of viral diseases in the world. It is not healthy to take vaccines against all viruses in the world. So instead of taking vaccines and medicines we have to boost our immunity. We can boost our immunity by doing three things. They are regular and proper physical

activity, maintain proper emotional health, and proper nutrition. The resource person reminded us that our country is now the capital of many non-communicable diseases. Also, the death rate due to non-communicable disease is very high in our country. The life expectancy of doctors is very low in India. It is about 55-60 years, which is lower than the life expectancy of common people.

Dr. A. Shershah said that a teacher will be behind the success of any person, working in any field. But now due to current corona virus outbreak our education system have been collapsed. Now teachers are engaged in many other activities. He hoped that we will overcome this situation very soon. The presentation session was concluded by thanking participants and saying that teachers can do better than doctors.

The next session was question-answer session. Many questions were asked related to usage of masks, teacher student relationship, physical fitness opportunity for the ordinary people etc. Our teaching faculty Dr. Pramod G. Nair asked about post covid era. As a replay the resource person asked Sri. Amjith sir to share his experience about the covid duty. He said that we can prevent any disease through proper physical exercise. But over exercise will wash out the antibodies from our body. So, he insisted never to go out for too much exercise. The session was ended by saying that a teacher must work to come out from current pandemic situation by providing awareness to the public.

On the midst of the present pandemic situation and the changing life styles, the future of education also lies in question. But, education still acts as an instrument for changing the minds, the civilizations, and the world. It was an international webinar and Ms. **Urnaib Shamshad**, Mentor in the New York Academy of Sciences, USA, PGT (Chemistry) in Ministry of Education (UAE) was the resource person.

The webinar started at sharp 10.30 A.M with around 100 participants. The compering was done by Ms Anisha.M Kumar and she invited Ms Aswathy for singing the prayer song 'Daivadashakam'. After that, she invited Dr.Viji ,the Convenor of the programme for Welcome address. She welcomed the resource person and all others to the session and a question put before them; 'education itself never change, then whom would to be changed?'.

The presidential address was done by Dr.Sheeba.P, the Principal and General Convenor of the Webinar. She related the importance of the upcoming resource talk as to the benefits of the student teachers because the resource person herself is excelling in teaching and doing some projects of international welfare.

Ms.Anisha then invited Dr. Smitha.S, Convenor and IQAC Coordinator, for giving felicitation. She remained us the need for taking precautions to equip the teaching profession in order to meet the 'new normal' pandemic situation.

The Introduction of the Resource Person was handled by Dr.Rani K.V. by making a breaf sketch of Urnaib Shamshad, the youngest and energetic teacher and worker in Environment protection at international levels.

The platform then set ready for listening the resource talk. MS Urnaib first invited everyone to his talk and the starting itself was in an interactive mode. By showing a picture ,she provided the participants a Padlet to write 'the picture denotes what?' She was so happy when the audience responses were active and she explained the difference between the traditional chalk&board method of teaching versus the activity based methos.

The presentation progresed with the use of PPT and vedios and the audience got everything she conveyed in its real sense. She stressed that with the technological advancement and changing scenario, the teachers should be well equipped in order to inspire the children. The teachers must have to change with the changing world in order to motivate the children, by listening them in achieving their dreams. Let the students to explore.

In order to provide the 21st century skills to students, the teacher should be updated and change the strategy to 'Student Centred Learning'. And, it works in four ways: through personalization of learning, competency-based learning, discovery learning and recognize that learning takes place anytime, anywhere. To achieve these, the Learning, Literacy and Life skills have to be acquired.

She strengthened her ideas by presenting her practical experiences with her students in different schools where she worked such as New Delhi, New York, etc. Those experienced lessons made us aware that the incorporation of Collaboration, Communication, Creative thinking, Critical thinking, and Project-based Learning are the central to the Child Centred Learning Strategy.

After sharing her wonderful ideas and experiences, she described about the Projects she did. Her first Project was on the "Reduction of the Biodegradable Waste".It was a commitment to reduce the plastic wastes organised under TAP, (The Achievers Programme) of The Annual International Youth Conference.



Those experienced lessons made us aware that the incorporation of Collaboration, Communication, Creative thinking, Critical thinking, and Project-based Learning are the central to the Child Centred Learning Strategy. Resource Person: Sri.E.K.Jijan(Assistant Professor, Mount Tabor Training College, Pathanapuram)



Pleading the Almighty for a better tomorrow, we started our webinar series with Guru's Daivadashakam sang by Adithya Manu at 10:30 a.m. The topic of the webinar was **Online Student Engagement and Support- Teacher Readiness for Challenges and Changes** by Sri E.K. Jijan, Assistant Professor, Mount Tabor Training College Pathanapuram. Neeni.S.L., the student teacher of Sree Narayana Training College Nedunganda did the anchoring of the webinar. She invited Dr.Reetha Ravi H, Assistant professor, SNTC & convener of the programme for the welcome address. Smt.Reetha Ravi welcomed all and introduced the resource person to us. More than 120 participants attended the webinar from different educational institutions across Kerala.

The presidential address was presided over by Dr Sheeba P (Principal, SNTC). First of all she told the importance of the webinar topic. That is, she asserted the relevance of it in the present scenario. She wished a great success to webinar and concluded her words by once again welcoming Sri. E. K. Jijan. Smt. Chitra. S(Assistant Professor, SNTC) made a felicitation speech. It was followed by the introduction of resource person by Dr.Smitha.S.(IQAC, Coordinator). It was a detailed wonderful introduction. She welcomed Sri E.K.Jijan whole heartedly.

Sri.E.K. Jijan started his presentation by addressing everyone. He thanked SNTC team for inviting him as resource person. He said that the name of the topic; **Online Student Engagement and Support-Teacher Readiness for Challenges and Changes** is very apt.

In the first part of the webinar, he talked about the challenges and issues faced by all of us in this pandemic situation. Then he asked the students which is the best language. Students answered that every language is important. He replied that smile is the best language we can ever have. Then he discussed about the problems of teachers. It include lack of facilities, network issues, audio video issues, societal expectations, parents satisfaction interference and presence, ensuring engagement, attendance and participation, school and subject differences, stresses etc. He said that there shouldn't be attendance or test compulsion during this pandemic situation. Then he said about the online education in both private and government schools.

Later he focused on the problems of student teachers. Planning the lessons, poor class management and control, lack of facilities in practicing School, poor method of teaching, ineffective usage of teaching aids, inability to differentiate between the needs of the individual child and supervision are the major problems faced by student teachers. To avoid boredom he conducted some warm up activities. The students as well as eminent persons from different educational institutions responded well. It was really a great experience.

After the warm up session, he dealt with the practical strategies to promote student engagement. It include removing unnecessary barriers- change mind sets, give students a voice and a choice- give your students a say, engage first then connect to content, clarify your expectations-students are unlikely to succeed if they do not know what is expected of them, provide specific positive and frequent feedbacks- motivation matters, create many opportunities for hands- on learning allow mistakes, use group work and collaboration, encourage students to present and share works regularly.

He said that every school, college and educational institutions have a system of support. So now in the present situation they use video conferencing, online classes, webinars, Moodle etc for teaching learning process. But the problem or the challenge is in the case of small kids. Because if they do not properly engaged, the classes won't be beneficiary for them. This kids want to be with the peer group. They always prefer face-to-face learning than online learning. Then the resource person asked the listeners whether they prefer online class or real class. Everyone responded that they prefer real class.


Then he talked about direct video recording and the use of white, black and digital board. He showed a video of Sai Swetha teacher's online teaching and explained the peculiarities of her way of narration, voice modulation, speed etc. For relaxation, he conducted some warm up activities again. Then he suggested ways to do lesson planning and preparation of templates/scripts. He was in the opinion that in this pandemic period all these work should be completed through online. We have to be adapted to it. Then he said about the various softwares that will help us to prepare digital lesson plan including MS Word MS Office Google document Google slide etc. It was succeeded by the preparation of achievement test and blue print.

Next topic was e content development. A definition of e content was given by the resource person. He showed an e content video done by a student teacher. The main queries of the students regarding e content development were solved. It included how to screen record and send it to someone, how to prepare only quizzes, how to convert a PDF file into Flip book, how to make rubrics and e portfolio. He concluded his presentation by showing concept mapping samples. "Thanks for your attendance keep a smile on your face", his concluding slide showed.

Then there was Q&A session. In the session Gayathri Dileep, one of the student teachers of SNTC asked a relevant question. The question was "Can digital lesson plans replace traditional lesson plans (written mode) in the present scenario or traditional lesson plan is necessary with the digital one?". The resource person answered that in his personal opinion, he prefers digital lesson plan. He added that anyhow we have to follow the university guidelines too.

In the evaluation session Dr. Ancy Jayaraj was in the opinion that the webinar was really informative. She said that it helps the students to get a clear idea about preparing digital lesson plans and conducting online classes. Aswathy khosh,the student teacher of SNTC also said that the webinar presentation was really effective.

Another Student teacher, Neeni. S. L told that the webinar was simple, but interactive. She added that the warm up session was really superb. Moreover in the chat box, students responded that it was really interesting and inspirational session. The session ended up with the vote of thanks by Ms Jaseena. P, student teacher of SNTC. Webinar-7 Topic:

'Cardiopulmonary Bypass and Cardiac Surgery'

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in collaboration with all departments of Sree Narayana Training College, Nedunganda organized a webinar series 'Intelligentia beyond disciplines-cross disciplinary collaboration in education'; conducted webinar series with the talks of eminent personalities in various fields. As part of this programme, 7th National webinar was conducted on 17th Oct 2020, Saturday. It was titled as 'Cardiopulmonary bypass and Cardiac Surgery'. Our resource talk was carried out by Dr. Bineesh K Radhakrishnan, Associate professor in Sree Chithira Thirunnal Institute of Medical Science and Technology. He was right person for the talk and conveners of the programme were Dr.Rani.K.V, Sri.Amjith.S and Dr.Smitha.S assistant professors from Sree Narayana Training College, Nedunganda. The programme was compared by Ms.Mesha from Physical Science department. She started the

session with wonderful words and prayer by Ms. Aswathy B.S from Mathematics department. Sri.Amjith.S Sir welcomed all the dignitaries and participants of our meeting. Our beloved Principal Dr.Sheeba.P officially inaugurated the session with abeautiful talk. Dr.Rani.K.V ma'am introduced the resource person in a deep sense of observation. Then she handed over the baton to our chief guest for the talk.


Dr.Bineesh.K.Radhakrishnan started his session with the quotes of famous personality Stephen Paget about cardio surgery. The quote was "Surgery of the heart probably has reached the limits set by the nature to all surgery; no new discovery can overcome the natural difficulties that attend a wound of the heart". He pointed out the milestones in the cardiac surgery. This include Ludwig Rehn, his surgery is considered the worldwide first successful direct suture of the heart. Firstly Dr. Bineesh k Radhakrishnan imparted knowledge about the anatomy and circulation of heart. He rightly explained about the inner side of heart for the participants. Then gave a description about valve orientation in human body, blood supply of heart. Next presented about surgery, here he imparted knowledge in both congenital and acquired .Congenital surgery include ASD, VSD, PDA etc. acquired include Valvular heart disease, CAD, Aneurysms etc. Then talk about special technique to operate heart. Next some great personalities Walton Lillehei, father of modern cardiac surgery, and John Gibbon. Then comes Cardio Pulmonary Bypass (CPB). This was the core of our webinar. In this he narrated the complete picture of the machine also explained what was the function of the machine when surgery occurs. During this session many of our participants clarify their doubts. He detailed about the different parts of heart and diseases that may be caused to heart. He also explained about the surgical method that is done to heart and on what situations we might face a cardio surgical process and how the surgery is done for each problem

When it came to the final part of the resource talk the doctor conveyed about Oxygenator. It is a device capable of exchanging oxygen and carbon dioxide in the blood of human patients during surgical procedures. At the end of the session he added the disadvantages of CPB. In this he noted the current scenario, Covid 19 patients with cardio disease. Then included some advantages of cardiac surgery. The first one was Minimally Invasive Cardiac Surgery. Here a camara is visualizing the things for the surgeon. This method is for selected people not for all. The second was Robotic Cardiac Surgery. Here robot is doing the cardiac surgery. The main advantage is robots hands are small so it can give more attention to wound, pain is comparatively less. The resource talk ended with C. Walton Lillehei's words. The doctor conveyed his ideas more clearly and effectively even-thought we common people can understood the things in a very informative manner. Doctor shared his knowledge about the cardiopulmonary bypass and cardiac arrest.

After the presentation time was allotted for the participents for more queries. Many asked questions and clarifies their doubs. Over all it was a very interactive and informative session.

The formal session come to an end with the delivery of vote of thanks by Ms. Anakha P Nath from mathematical optional. The students, other participants gave positive feedback for the webinar. The session was found to be beneficial and informative . Later on the students filled up the feedback form from the link provided in the chat box.




